Discussion

- UF has submitted a proposal to NSF 19-534 Advanced Computing Systems & Services: Adapting to the Rapid Evolution of Science and Engineering Research. The title is “Nimble Ecosystem for Science and engineering” abbreviated NIMBESE and pronounced like nimbus, the Latin word for cloud. We propose a system like HiPerGator 3.0 with ResVault secure computing included: it has 35,000 cores running at 2.7 GHz and 8.25 PB of storage with 1.4 PB of really fast NVMe storage. The RAM per core is 6.8 GB. There are 256 GPUs and 2 1.5 TB bigmem nodes.
- On Feb 19, RCAC met with Information Security Advisory Committee to discuss the feedback and changes we sent on the various policies under revision. The minutes were shared with the group. The discussion will continue on Mar 18. The meeting will be zoom enabled.
- The OneIT plan is being executed with plans being refined. The next version of the plan will be shared soon.
