## Updates

- **HITRUST certification of HiPerGator**
  - On April 17, 2023 HiPerGator received the status of certification by HITRUST under the CSF v9.6 risk-based, 2-year (r2) validated assessment program.
  - The documentation for the process to work with PHI and FERPA restricted data on HiPerGator can be found on the RC website <https://rc.ufl.edu> -> Documentation, under “Policies” and under “Procedures”, and under “Frequently Asked Questions”. Other websites have added a link to these pages to make sure faculty can find this information.
  - The Archer screens have been updated to expedite the required registration of any project that wants to use HiPerGator with PHI or FERPA data.
  - A communication plan will be executed in the next few weeks to spread the news.
- **UFIT Research Computing staff changes**
  - RC has hired a new training in AI support engineer and a new facilitator.
  - The IT manager of the DevOps team will start April 28.

- **HiPerGator long-term budget**
  - UF leadership is considering the strategy for long-term maintenance and health of the HiPerGator investments and the donation from Malachowsky and NVIDIA. The approach taken is to bring annual updates to a part of the HiPerGator system to ensure that current technology is always available to UF researchers and students. More details will be communicated when they become available.
