The project will identify needs during phase 1, and then evaluate ITSM tools during phase 2. Recommendations will be presented to SIAC, and then to the IT Policy Council. All of this will take about 6 months. Phase 3 will follow with ITSM Tool Implementation and Process Rollout. The implementation phase will be managed by Enterprise Systems.

Adams met with workgroup chairs and steering committee members, to talk about problems with the current system (Remedy). A Remedy Stabilization Project will proceed in parallel.

 - o First meeting will be Friday 4/26/13
- System Implementation
 - o May UF Computing Help Desk staff will get onto Office 365 first. As they learn to use the application(s), they will begin developing documentation.
 - o June Pilot groups will be invited to test drive Office 365 and provide feedback.
 - o July New students will be provisioned in Office 365, and existing students will be encouraged to begin voluntary migration from GatorLink to Office 365.
 - o Communications team is building an informational web-site with FAQs.
 - o Identity & Access Management (IAM) team is working on the details of provisioning.
 - o UFIT/ISC (Security) is also involved, reviewing everything and providing guidance.
- Open questions yet to be resolved are:
 - o Should we allow auto FORWARD?
 - o Should we allow IMAP?

- Eduroam -- Federated Wireless Access [https://www.eduroam.org/]
 - CIO Eldayrie requested CNS to provide eduroam -- allows visitors from other participating institutions to access UF Wi-Fi using their 'home' credentials.

 - Target implementation date is July 9, for the main campus.
