- Per Susan Blair/Privacy Office: policy allows student records, but not transcripts or SSNs.
- Anyone with a GatorLink ID and Password can use the service.
- Uses HTML5 features. MSIE not the best choice browser. Firefox, Chrome, Safari better.
- Erik Deumens & Jon Akers (HPC) will take over system maintenance and user support.

- Network Access Control/Posture Assessment
- July 16th unified NAC/PA moves from warning mode to blocking mode. Checking for:
 - Current Windows OS patch levels
 - Current Flash & Java versions
 - Viruses & anti-malware
 - P2P software
- Active on Wi-Fi networks provided by CNS, Housing, and AHC. Coming soon on UF Foundation and UF Athletics Association networks.
- o 2 week grace period at the beginning of each semester will drop back to Warning Mode. (8/13 Warning Mode – 9/15 blocking mode).
- o Blocked users are redirected to a web page with links for updating their system to bring it to acceptable 'posture.'
- Robinson: What about awareness campaign for 9-month faculty?
 - Dan: Working with Tracy Gale on publicity: sending through Gator Times, Provost newsletter, other things targeted at faculty.
 - Frey: Suggests CNS provide an email to Directors to send to their users.
 - And "every other avenue you can think of"

Additional Service Offerings

- See handout (2012-06-26 OSG Proposed Hosting-presentation.xlsx).
- Allows for independent scaling of memory ('RAM') and storage (disk).
 - \$8 for the base VM w/2 gigs memory plus however many additional 2gig chunks you want, plus however much additional storage you want.

Cost and Price Reductions

- Sedesse notes that these are NOT subsidized rates. OSG has been working to get the cost down to where this is now an actual-cost pass-through charge.
- New equipment is on order. New prices will become effective October 1, 2012.

Capacity and Demand

- Use of Hosting Services increased about 40% over the last year.
- Similar increases are anticipated for next year.

Committee Endorsement

No objections noted. Olson & Bailey said they were very pleased with the proposal.

Related Services

- o Tim mentioned a possible new UF-run storage-on-demand service for faculty & staff (similar to the 'box.net' offering from Internet2).
- o Could be fee-for-service offering comparable to the prices shown on Iain's spreadsheet.
- o The box.net price is based on institution size: for UF, it would be ~\$200K/year minimum.
- o Olson: There is a real need for this type of service. Faculty are going all over the place for this sort of thing, and creating a lot of data exposure. The sooner UF gets into this business, the better.
